

Set next to Museum Campus and including Printers Row, the large South Loop is a lively hub of classic bars and diverse restaurants, plus longtime clubs Jazz Showcase and Buddy Guy's Legends. The Motor Row area, designated a Chicago Landmark in 2000, is located on Michigan Ave., just South of Cermak Ave. and West of McCormick Place Convention Center. Buildings in the area were constructed between 1905 & 1936. Throughout the neighborhood's history, Chicago's Motor Row has been home to many of Chicago's big shoulders; including Marshall Field and Al Capone who called 22nd and Michigan Ave. his "home turf". At the turn of the century, Motor Row was famous for featuring more than 116 different makes of automobiles; they were sold and repaired on this historic district of Michigan Ave. – Google, choosechicago.com
